NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of States (Greenville,

on the Enorse hiver, being two lots, one containing 16 acres, more or less, and the other containing 51 acres, more or less, and being more particularly described as follows:

51 acres: BEGINNING at a corner in the said Encree River 3xom, and running thence N. 22 W. 14.25 to a walnut stump, 3xom, now stone, 3xom; thence N 59 W. 27.75 to stone 3xom, in autherford Road; thence with said Road to the River; thence down the meanders of said Encree River to the beginning corner.

16 acres: BEGINNING at a stone on the bank of Enorse River at the mouth of the Creek, and running thence up said River to a stone, 3x, on line of the above mentioned tract of land; thence N. \$25 3/4 W. 13.85 to a walnut stump (now stone, nm); thence N. 62 1/4 E. 10.29 to a stone, 3xnm, on the bank of the Creek; thence down the meanders of said creek to the beginning corner.
