ULDRICK BROTHERS, INC., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of **Eleven Thousand and No/100** -----

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, known and designated as Lot 28 of Broadmoor Subdivision, as shown by plat made by Piedmont Engineering Service dated July, 1960, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book RR at Page 47, said lot having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a pin at the joint front corner of Lots #28 and #29 on the northern side of Woodbury Circle and running thence with the northern side of Woodbury Circle S. 85-41 E. 116 feet to a pin at the curve of the intersection of Woodbury Circle and Holmsby Lane; thence with the curve of said intersection N. 48-39 E. 34.7 feet to a pin on the western side of Holmsby Lane; thence with the western side of Holmsby Lane N. 2-59 E. 100.6 feet to a pin at the joint front corner of Lots 28 and 27; thence with the line of Lot 27 S. 77-15 W. 139.6 feet to a pin at the rear corner of Lot 29; thence with the line of Lot 29 S. 4-19 W. 105 feet to the beginning corner.
