NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to of for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolinia, County of Greenville, in Gleveland Township, containing 9½ acres, more or less, located near the Gap Creek Baptist. Church, lying on the Eastern side of Gap Creek, being bounded on the North by a road that leads to the Girl Scout Camp; on the East by lands now or formerly owned by T. B. Potts: on the South by lands of P. D. now or formerly owned by T. B. Potts; on the South by lands of P. D. Tankersley; on the West by Gap Creek and lands now or formerly owned by T. B. Potts and being further described as follows:
