"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, Iying and being the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Saluda Township, on some small branches of the North Fork of Saluda River, being a part of the land formerly owned by Odom Cox, and known as Tract No. 2 on Plat made by W. W. Hunt on September 20, 1888, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a large pine on the line of W. C.
