to Liberty Life Insurance Company shall be paid as follows:

- A. UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE PRINCIPAL BALANCE SHALL

 BE REDUCED TO FIFTEEN THOUSAND (\$15,000,00) DOLLARS.
- 1. All rentals received from the "Pickwick Shopping Center" shall be deposited to the credit of the Rental Account heretofore maintained by Edgar and Francis Odom.
