Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate situated in Greenville.

Beginning at a point in the "ortheast corner of Virginia Mrg Co. property, on the Western margin of an unnamed county road, thence in a western direction along the northern line of Virginia Mfg. co property, 175 feet to a point; thence in a northerly direction parallel with said county road 150 feet to a point; thence in an easterly direction, perpendicular to the said county road 170 feet to a point; on the western margin of said county road; thence running in a southern direction on the western margin of said county road 150 feet bact to the point of beginning.

Together with alt and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in wise incident or appertaining, or that hereafter may be erected or placed thereon.
