## OUT 10 THE STATE MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in contributeration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to, or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bergained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying end being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Highland Township, this being a part of the Bennie Hart home place and lying north of the Tutaloo hoad and bounded on the east by land of Harry Lee Hart, on the north by land of Floyd Plumley; on the west and south by land of Mary H. Jordan, and having the following corses and distances, to-wit:

PEGINING at a maple on Mary H. Jordan line and runs east 60 feet, more or less to a sweet gum tree; thence in a north direct 105 feet, more or less, to Helen Plumiky's line; thence with the Plumiky line 60 feet/more or less to an iron pin; also Mary H. Jordan corner; thence in a south direction 135 feet more or less, to a maple tree, the beginning corner and containing 29/100 acres, more or less.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully saized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute that it has good right and is fairfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided berein. The Mortgagor currier covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagor forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
