WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagoe) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Eighteen Thousand and no/100---

DOLLARS (\$ 18,000.00---), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Five & one-half per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be regald in monthly instalments of

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagor at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagor, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Creenville," on the Eastern side of Augusta Street in the City of Greenville and being lot? 7 and a portion of Lot 6 as shown on a plat of the property of Mills and McBrayer, recorded in Deed Book EEE at page 301, and described as follows:

BEGINNING AT AN iron pin on the Eastern side of Augusta Street, 91 feet North from University Ridge at the corner of Lot 8 and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 47-45 E. 162 feet to an iron pin on Perry Alley; thence with the Western side of said Alley, N. 38- E. 40 feet to iron pin at corner of property conveyed to C. Kirby Hammond in Deed Book 455 at page 529, and running thence with the line of said property, N. 47-50 W. 60 feet, S. 38-51 W. 14.85 feet and N. 48-01 W. 100.1 feet to an iron pin on Augusta Street; thence with the Eastern side of Augusta Street, S. 40-30 W. 25 feet to the Beginning corner.
