TRACT 2. ALL that tract of land with all improvements thereon, situate, lying, and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the North side of Wade Hampton Boulevard (U. S. Highway No. 29) near the Town of Taylors, S. C., and having according to a plat of property of T. M. Hughes, made by R. K. Campbell, Engineer, November 21, 1960, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book UU, at page 140, the following description:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Wade Hampton Boulevard (U. S. Highway No. 29) at a point lying approximately 1360 feet in an Eastern direction from the intersection of Edwards Road, and running thence with property now or formerly of Howell, N. 15-16 W. 423.1 feet to an iron pin; thence with property now or formerly of Edwards, S. 74-20 E. 124.7 feet to an iron pin; thence with property now or formerly of Hudson, S. 21-05 E. 354.1 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Wade Hampton Boulevard; thence with the said Wade Hampton Boulevard, S. 50-33 W. 175 feet to the point of beginning.

TRACT 3. ALL my interest in and to that tract of land with all improvements thereon situate, lying, and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the East side of Camp Road, and on the South side of Cuttino Road, and having according to a survey made by R. K. Campbell, R.E., dated December, 1957, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at the Southeast intersection of Camp Road and Cuttino Road and running thence with the South side of Cuttino Road, S. 64-55 E. 505.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10-01 E. 132 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 77-15 W. 175.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 36-04 W. 257.7 feet to an iron pin, N. 05-30 W. 270.5 feet to a point in the East side of Camp Road; thence with the East side of Camp Road, N. 25-25 E. 175 feet to the beginning point.

TRACT 4. ALL my interest in and to that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying, and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lots 9 and 10 of property of Hughes and Cale, according to a plat thereof made by Piedmont Engineering Service, April, 1955, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Cahu Drive, at joint front corner of Lots 10 and 11 and thence with the line of Lot 11, N. 4-31 E. 150.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 35-29 E. 189.9 feet, joint rear corner of Lots 8 and 9; thence with the line of Lot 8, S. 7-33 W. 150.7 feet to an iron pin at the North side of Cahu Drive; thence with the North side of Cahu Drive, N. 35-29 W. 130 feet to the point of beginning.

TRACT 5. ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land located in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near Duncan Mills Village, located on the northern side of National Highway No. 29, being known as Lot No. 1, Section A, according to a plat of Marsmen, Inc., made by G.
