BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Hiawatha Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 219 and 220 of Sector V, Botany Woods, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 220 S. 4-52 W. 171.3 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 30, Morningside; thence with the line of Lot No. 3) N. 54-39 W. 19 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos., 29 and 30; thence continuing with the line of Lot No. 30 S. 49-07 W. 34 feet to an iron pin; thence a new line through Lot No. 29 N. 51-24 W. 146.2 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Hiawatha Drive; thence with the Southeastern side of Hiawatha Drive the following courses and distances: $\dot{\rm N}$. 42-45 E. 38 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 57-11 E. 85 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 69-45 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 88-39 E. 25.6 feet to the point of beginning.
