WHEREAS,

J. P. STEGALL

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto

SOUTHERN BANK & TRUST COMPANY

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of

TWO THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100ths - - - - - Dollars (\$ 2,500.00) due and payable in equal monthly payments of **\$110.81**, first applied to interest and balance to principal, beginning March 15, 1962, and **\$110.81** on the 15th day of each month thereafter until paid in full,

with interest thereon from date at the rate of **6** per centum per annum, to be paid: **monthly**

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, at the Northwestern corner of Gordon Street and Owens Street, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 52 on plat of Earle Subdivision of the Looper Yown Property made by R. E. Dalton in May, 1922, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "P" at Page 77, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake at the Northwestern corner of Gordon Street and Owens Street, and running thence with the Western side of Owens Street, N. 10-15 W. 200 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 53; thence with the line of said lot, S. 79-45 W. 185 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 50; thence with the line of said lot, S. 10-15 E. 200 feet to a stake on Gordon Street; thence with the Northern side of Gordon Street, N. 79-45 E. 185 feet to the beginning corner."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by W. H. Mauldin, Sheriff, by deed dated December 6, 1945, recorded in Book of Deeds 306 at Page 344.

Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
