NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgage at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Western side of Selwyn Drive near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Not No. 18 as shown on a plat prepared by Dalton & Neves, dated July, 1955, entitled "Timberlake", recorded in the Ram.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book BB at page 185, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

DECIMINO at an iron pin on the Western side of Selwyn Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 17 and 18, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 17 S. 34-16 W. 240 feet to an iron pin on the subdivision property line; thence with the subdivision property line S. 5-44° E. 90 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 13 and 19; thence with the line of Lot No. 19 N. 84-16 E. 240 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Selwyn Drive; thence with the Western side of Selwyn Drive N. 5-44 W. 90 feet to the point of beginning.
