Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the samesbelonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all licating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now of hireafter attached, connected, or litted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fix stures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

a The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in few simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are tree and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant undeforever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagor forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof:

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:-

- 1. That he will promptly pay the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein, and also any further loans advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager by the Mortgagee; and that all stimp so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the Mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That he will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Moitgaged against loss by fire and other hazards, in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgaged and in companies acceptable to it, and that he does hereby assign to the Mortgaged all such policies, and the hazards thereof shall be field by the Mortgaged and have attached thereto loss payable glauses in taylor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgaged.
- 1. That he will keep all improvements new existing or hereafter erected upon the mortgaged property in good repair, and should be fail to do so, the Mortgagee may at its option, enter upon said premises, make what ever repairs are necessary, and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt; that, in the event that the proceeds of this loan are for the construction of improvements on the mortgaged premises, he will continue construction until completion, without interruption, and should be fail to do so, the Mortgagee may its option, enter upon said premises, complete said construction work, and charge the expenses for the completent of such construction to the mortgage debt.
- 5. That the Mortgagee spay require the maker, co-maker or endorser of any indebtedness secured hereby to carry life insurance upon himself-in a sum sufficient to pay all sums secured by this mortgage, designating the Mortgagee as beneficiary thereof, and upon failure of the Mortgagor to pay the premiums therefor, the Mortgagee may at its option, pay said premiums, and all sims so alkaneed by the Mortgagee shall become a part of mortgage debt.
- 6. That together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each month, until the indebtedness secured hereby is paid in full, a sum equal to one-twelfth of the annual tracks, public assessments and insurance premiums, as estimated by the Mortgagee, and, on the failure of the Mortgagor to pay all taxes, insurance premiums and public assessments, the Mortgagee may, at its option, pay said items and charge all advances therefore to the mortgage debt.
- 7. That he hereby assigns all the rents, issues, and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Mortgages shall have the right to have at receiver appointed of the rents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all chayges and expenses attending such proceedings and the execution of his trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
- 8. That, at the option of the Mortgagee, the mortgage shall become due and payable forthwith if the Mortgagor shall convey away said mortgaged bremises, or if the title shall become vested in any other person in any manner whatsoever other than by death of the Mortgagor, or, in the case of a construction loan; if the Mortgagor shall permit work on the project to become and remain interrupted for a period of fifteen (15) class.

It is agreed that the Mortgagor shall hold and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there's a default under this mortgage or in the note secured hereby. It is the true meaning of athis instrument that if the Mortgagor shall fully perform all the terms, conditions, and covenants of this mortgage and of the note secured hereby this mortgage shall be utterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. If there is a default in any of the terms, conditions or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgagee; all sums then owing by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee shall become immediately due and payable and this mortgage may be foreclosed. Should any legal proceedings be nattituded for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgagee become a party to any suit involving this Mortgage or the title to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured hereby or any part thereof backlaced in the hands of an attorney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and expenses incurred by the Mortgagee, and a reasonable attorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and payable, immediately or on demand; at the option of the Mortgagee, as a part of the debt secured hereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.

The covenants, agreements and conditions herein contained shall bind, and the benefits and advantages shall inure to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular number shall include the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders.
