John C. Yacobi, of Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings;

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of **Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty & no/100 Dollars (\$14,750.00)**, with interest from date at the rate of **five & one-fourth per centum (5 1/4%)** per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of **Three Dollars (\$3)** to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina, near **Greenville, S. C.**, known as **Lot 80** on plat of **Pine Brook**, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book **Z** at page **148**, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Bidwell Street at the corner of Lot 82, which iron pin is 194 feet southeast of the curved intersection of Bridges Avenue and running thence along the southwestern side of Bidwell Street, S 33-31 E, 75 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 78, S 56-29 W, 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N 33-31 W, 75 feet to an iron pin; thence N 56-29 E, 150 feet to the point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
