NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I we, the said mortgagor (a) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the did mortgagor (s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and telease unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property to wit:

"All that certain piece parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and king in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, about one mile north of Brushy Creek Baptist Church, lying on the northern side of the road that leads from Brushy Creek Church to the Lee Road, and being a part of a 8. 17 acre tract conveyed to Carl Hammond by deed from Nannie B. James during the year 1952, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

"BEGINNING on an old nail and cap in the center of the said road, joint corner of James W. haw land, and runs thence with the common line of Carl Hammond and James W. Shaw, N. 25-40 E. 25 feet to an iron pin on the northern bank of the road; thence continuing with the same course for a total distance of 222. 4 feet to an iron pin on the said line; thence S. 80-17 E. 109.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 25-27 W. 197.6 feet to a nail and cap in the said road (iron pin back on line at 15 feet); thence with the said road, S. 88-16 W. 119 feet to the beginning corner, containing one-half (0.50) of one acre, more or less; being the same conveyed to us by Carl Hammond by his deed dated December 30, 1959, recorded in the R M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 641, at page 540.
