All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 93, Section I, Lake Forest Subdivision, as shown on a plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book GG at page 17, and having according to a more recent plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated January 14, 1956, entitled "Property of Charles H. Huff", the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Lake Fairfield Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 93 and 94, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 94 S. 17-32 W. 192 feet to a point were the joint line of Lots Nos. 93 and 94 intersects the high water line of Lake Fairfield; thence along the high water line of Lake Fairfield, having a traverse line of S. 79-51 E. 201 feet to a point where the joint line of Lots Nos. 92 and 93 intersects the high water line of Lake Fairfield and being in the center of a drainage easement; thence through the center of said drainage easement and with the line of Lot No. 92 N. 10-21 W. 225.4 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Lake Fairfield Drive; thence with the curve of Lake Fairfield Drive, the chord of which is S. 87-52 W., 100 feet to the point of beginning.
