WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto TRAVELERS REST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF Travelers Rest, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Nine Thousand and no/100

DOLLARS (\$9,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, known as a portion of Lot 25 as shown on plat entitled H. M. Spears, being a revision of Lot 25 of Nabors & Bridges Property in plat book 0 at page 195, and having, according to the first mentioned plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Long Forest Drive and running thence N 27-03 W, 448.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S 32-06 W, 300.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S 51-44 E, 346.3 feet to the northern side of said Drive; thence along said Drive, N 53-21 E, 115.4 feet to the point of beginning and being a portion of that property conveyed to me in deed book 392 at page 406.
