in the full and just sum of -----Eleven Hundred Ninety-two and 18/100 (\$), 192.18) Dollars, in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable

in monthly installments of Twelve (\$12.00) Dollars each, the first such installment to become due and payable on the 1st day of June, 1963, and a like installment to become due on the 1st day of each and every month thereafter until the above sum has been paid in full, said payments to apply first to interest and then to the reduction of principal,

with interest thereon from date

at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly, as above set forth, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear
