"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Oneal Township, on the northern side of the Gap Creek Road, being bounded on the east by lands of J.H.
