NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, barses gained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville. in Chick Springs Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 54 on a plat of the property of Woodland Heights, recorded in Plat Book GG at Page 151, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Bessie Avenue, at joing front corner of Lots 53 and 54, and running thence along the line of Lot 53.N. 39-01.W. 233 feet to iron pin; thence S. 39-20 W. 101.1 feet to pin at corner of Lot 55; thence with the line of Lot 55, S. 39-01 E. 222 feet to pin on Bessie Avenue; thence with the northern side of Bessie Avenue, N. 54-18 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

The Mortgagors agree that after the expiration of ten years from the date hereof, the Mortgagee may at its option apply for mortgage insurance for an additional period of five years with the mortgage insurance company insuring this loan, and the Mortgagors agree to pay to the Mortgagee as premium for such insurance one-half of one per cent of the principal balance then existing.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or apportaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment of fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fix tures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
