Barbare and others, and having the following courses and distances, towit:

BEGINNING at a point in said road, southeast corner of said lot, and running thence N. 64.45 W. 413.5 feet to pine; thence N. 14.57 E. 352 feet to stake in big gully; thence along the fully, S. 55.44 E. 164.8 feet to stake; thence S. 58.49 E. 333 feet to center of said road; thence along said road, S. 30.03 W. 200 feet to bend; thence along said road, S. 24.48 W. 86.5 feet to the beginning corner.
