"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Groonville in the Woodside Mills Village in the Town of Simpsonville, and being more particularly described as lot No. 46 as shown on a plat entitled "A Subdivision of Woodside Mills, Simpsonville, SC" made by Piedmont Engineering Service, Greenville, S. C., February 1953 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "GG" at page 5. According to said plat, the within described lot is also Known as No. 31 "A" Street and fronts thereon 84 feet.
