One Hundred Fifteen and 67/100 - - - - (\$ 115.67) Dollars upon the first day of each and every chlerelar month herea(ter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid, such monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal. The last payment on said note, if not paid earlier and if not subsequently acces, and then to the payment of principal. The last payment on said note, if not paid earlier and if not subsequently extended, will be due and payable $2^{\frac{1}{2}}$. Years after date. The note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be pastedue and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or, failure to comply with any of the Hydraws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder, become interest of the said in the holder said, see thereon and foreless this mortgage, said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorneys fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereoffel the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected, by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all, which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN. That I we, the gaid mortgagor (s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better accurring the parameter to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Bullars to me/us the said mortgagor (s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS, AND EOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereal is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, self-and selease unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wes:

"All that certain piece, @cel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Butler Township, being known and designated as Lot 16 of a subdivision known as Spring Forest according to a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, April 1963, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book XX at Page 126 and having, according to said plat; the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"REGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of the Old Spartanburg Road at the joint front corner of Lots 16 and 17% running thence along the joint line of said lots S. 7-21 E. 185.7 foot to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 16 and 17; running thence along the lines of Lots 25 and 26. N. 81-35 E. 120 feet to an iron pin on the wester iide of Beaufort Street and running thence along the western side of said Beaufort Street, N. 7-23 W. 156 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of said Beaufort Street and the Old Spartanburg Road; thence with the curvature of said intersection, the chord of which in N. 52-59 W. 35.7 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of the Old Spartanburg Road; thence along southern side of Old Spartanburg Road, S. 83-49 W. 95 feet to the point of beginning."

In addition to the above mentioned monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, the mortgagor(s) agree(s) to pay to the mortgages on the first day of each month until the note secured by this instrument is fully paid, the following sums: a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged proporty, plus taxes, and assessments next due on the regrigaged property (all as estimated by the mortgagee) lean all sums already paid therefor, divided by the number of months to clapse before one month prior to the date when such premiums, taxes, and assessments will be due and payable, such sums to be held by mortgagee in escrow to pay said promiums, taxes and special assessments. Should these payments exceed the amount of

payments actually made by the mortgagee for taxes, assessments, or Insurance premiums, the excess may be credited by the mortgagee on subsequent payments to be made by the mortgagor(s); if, however, said nums shall be insufficient to make said payments when the same shall become due and payable, the mortgagor(s) shall pay to the mortgagee any amounts necessary to make up the deficiency.
