Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgage become a party of any suit involving this Mortgage or the title to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of any attorney, at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and expenses incurred by the Mortgage, and a reasonable attorney if the, shall this upon become due and payable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgage, as a part of the debt secured hereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.
