and being known and designated as lots Nos. 1 to 4 in Block "I" on
 plat recorded in Plat Book "G" at page 129 in R.M.C. Office for
 Greenville County, and situate about 2 1/2 miles from Greenville
 County Court House on north side of branch on State Highway No. 81,
 formerly Old Anderson Road, BEGINNING at 10 foot alley from branch &
 said State Highway thence along north side of Highway 195 feet to
 Collins line to a pin; thence a northwesternly course along Collins
 line 147 feet to a pin on 10 foot alley; thence 50 feet along alley
 in a southwesternly direction to Harvard Street to a pin; thence a
 northwesternly direction along east side of Harvard Street 60 feet to
 an iron pin to Gettis Hipps corner; thence along said Hipps line in
 a northeasternly direction 155 feet to Hipps corner and said alley to
