"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Gantt Township, and being part of the N. Lee Simpson homeplace and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwestern intersection of U. S. Hwy. 29 and entrance to Oakvale Drive-In Theatre and running thence S. 84-36 W. 606 feet to a point in the center of the Railroad; thence in a northeasterly direction along the center of said Railroad to a point at the southwestern corner of property heretofore conveyed by J.
