NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgager, in consideration of the aferesaid debt, and in order to secure the psyment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, containing 14.56 acres known as tract 1 of the W. J. Monroe Estate according to plat of W. J. Riddle dated May, 1952 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book CC at Page 87, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit:
