bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

E. L. Craigo, his heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with buildings and improve-
ments thereon in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State
of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 9 of Riverdale
Acres, property of I. H. Philpot, Trustee shown on plat recorded in
Plat Book GG, at page 127 and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Sulphur Springs Drive,
front corner of Lots 8 and 9 and running thence with the line of said
lots, S. 83-57 E. 175.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 9-18 E. 90.2
feet; thence N. 80-42 W. 175 feet to said drive; thence with said
