

Jones Bridge Road; thence N. 30-45 W. 1374 feet to a stake; thence N. 59-30 E. 480 feet to the beginning corner. This property is bounded on the north by property of International Paper Company and United States Department of Agriculture (and South Carolina State Highway), on the southeast by property of United States Department of Agriculture, and on the west by property formerly belonging to Cecils Land and Improvement Company and now belonging to Continental Can Company, and on the northwest by other property of Cecils Land and Improvement Company. This property is known as the "Williams Tract" and was conveyed to Cecils Land and Improvement Company by deed of Cecil's, Incorporated, dated March 16, 1953, and recorded in Deed Book 112, page 552, and is a part of the property conveyed to Cecils Land and Improvement Company by deed of Mrs. Pearl Hays Stone, individually and as Executrix, recorded in Deed Book 105 at page 235, all in the Office of the Clerk of Court of Laurens County.
