WHEREAS, it appears from the records of Greenville County that on or about August 30, 1938, Ethel Smith Jones executed her note and mortgage to Southeastern Life Insurance Company in the original amount of SEVEN THOUSAND and NO/100 (\$7,000.00) DOLLARS, which mortgage was recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in R. E. M. Volume 231, Page 165, on August 30, 1938, and

WHEREAS, it appears from affidavit of G. H. Cleveland, an Assistant Secretary of Liberty Life Insurance Company that the Southeastern Life Insurance Company changed its name to Liberty Life Insurance Company on January 1, 1942; and according to the records of said Liberty Life Insurance Company, the said Company received full payment of the amount due on said mortgage and assigned said note and mortgage to T. E. Jones which assignment was never recorded, and

WHEREAS, the said T. E. Jones died testate on December 20, 1958, his sons Arthur E. Jones, Richard Abner Jones, Paul G. Jones, Conway Jones, and his daughter, Ethel Jones Swink, were appointed Executors and Executrix of his estate, and Letters Testamentary were granted to them by the Judge of Probate of Greenville County on November 30, 1959, as shown by administration of the estate of T. E. Jones in Apt. 698, File 19, in the Probate Court for Greenville County, and

WHEREAS, the said Arthur E. Jones has since died testate on July 30, 1963, and
