The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

- (1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such fur ther sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. - (3) That it will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected in good repair, and, in the case of a construction lean, that it will continue construction until completion without interruption, and should it fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary, including the completion of any construction work underway, and charge the expenses for such repairs or the completion of such construction to the mortgage debt.
- (4) That it will pay, when due, all taxes, public assessments, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines or other impositions against the mortgaged premises. That it will comply with all governmental and municipal laws and regulations affecting the mortgaged premises.
- (5) That it hereby assigns all rents, issues and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and agrees that, should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, any judge having jurisdiction may, at Chambers or etherwise, appoint a receiver of the mortgaged premises, with full authority to take possession of the mortgaged premises and collect the rents, issues and profits, including a reasonable rental to be fixed by the Court in the event said premises are accupied by the mortgager and after deducting all charges and expenses attending such preceding and the execution of its trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues and profits toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
- (6) That if there is a default in any of the terms, conditions, or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgages, all sums then ewing by the Maragager to the Mortgages shall become immediately due and payable, and this mortgage may be functioned. Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgages become a party of instituted the first title to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured herein and the function of any atterney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and gapeness incurred by the Mortgages, and a singular state of any atterney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and gapeness incurred by the Mortgages, and a singular state state and payable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgages, as a part of the state section hereby, and may be required and saffected foreunder.
- (7) That the Markinger shall hold and enjoy the premises above according until there is a default under this unertage or in the nate secured hereby, it is the true meening of this instrument that if the Mortgager shall fully perform all the terms, undiffers, and accounts of the mortgage, and of the note secured hereby, that then this mortgage shall be utterly null and void; etherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
- (8) That the covenants herein contained shall bind, and the benefits and advantages shall insure to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular shall included the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders.
