We, Jim C. Perry and

Dorothy D. Perry,

hereinafter called

the Mortgagor(s), SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, the said Mortgagor(s) in and by the certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these Presents, are well and truly indebted to The First National Bank of Greer,

a Corporation, hereinafter called Mortgagee, in the full and just sum of Twenty-five Hundred (\$2500.00) - - - - - DOLLARS,

to be paid as follows: \$40.00 on February 10, 1965, and like payments of \$40.00 on the 10th day of each successive month thereafter until paid in full, each of said payments to be first accredited to interest and the balance to the principal,

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor(s) paid by the said Mortgagee at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee, The First National Bank of Greer, its Successors and Assigns:

All that certain parcel or lot of land with improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greer, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot No. 48, as shown on a plat entitled "A Subdivision for McCall Manufacturing Company, Greer, S.C." made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, Greenville, S.C., May, 1949, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, page 76, According to said plat the within described lot is also known as No. 109 Mason Street and fronts thereon 135 feet.
