(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of ~~-----~~ TEN THOUSAND AND NO/100THS- ~~-----~~ DOLLARS (\$10,000.00), with interest thereon at the rate of five and one-half per cent per annum as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date herewith payable as therein stated, or as hereafter modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is fifteen years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, situate on the north-western side of Super Highway U. S. 29 containing 7 acres, more or less, and being shown and designated as Tract 34, Block 6, Page 15.3 of the County Block Book and being more particularly described by metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeastern corner of said tract of land at the right of way of Super Highway 29 and running thence with said right of way 485 feet, more or less, to pin where said right of way intersects with Yale Street; thence with the eastern side of Yale Street in a general northwesterly direction 700 feet, more or less, to pin where said Street intersects with line of Lots 51 and 52 as shown on plat of Super Highway Homesites; thence N. 43 E. 610 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence S. 30-30 E. 672.4 feet to the point of beginning.
