GERALD P. MOREY AND IRENE D. MOREY of
Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto CAMERON-BROWN COMPANY

, a corporation
organized and existing under the laws of the State of North Carolina, hereinafter
called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which
are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of -----EIGHT THOUSAND AND
NO/100-----Dollars (\$ 8,000.00-----), with interest from date at the rate
of Five and One-Fourth-----per centum (-----5 1/4 %) per annum until paid, said prin-
cipal and interest being payable at the office of

securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three
Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained,
sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its
successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County,
South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 71 according to a plat of
PARIS HEIGHTS, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book
Y, Page 65.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belong-
ing or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be
had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter
attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and
assigns forever.
