WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto CAROLINA NATIONAL MORTGAGE INVESTMENT CO., INC.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 4 of Paris Piney Park, plat of which is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "H" at Page 20; said lot fronting 50 feet along the South side of State Park Road, running back to a depth of 150 feet on the West side, to a depth of 150 feet on the East side of said lot along Orlando Avenue, and being 50 feet across the rear.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
