All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Oneal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 40.54 Acres, more or less, situated on the west side of State Highway No. 290 and both sides of State Highway No. S-262, about six miles northwestward from the City of Greer near Double Springs Baptist Church, and being shown on a plat of the property of O.I. Black according to survey and plat by Terry T. Dill, Registered Surveyor, dated August 20, 1964, and being further shown on a plat of the F.W. Andrea property recorded in Plat Book OO, page 244, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:
