"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all Improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and described as Lot No. 33, as shown on a plat of Paris Heights recorded in Plat Book Y, at page 65, and being more particularly described according to a recent survey prepared by C.C. Jones, as follows:
