J. L. Elmore, his heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about 51/4 miles East of the City of Greenville on the Old Spartanburg Road, containing 25 acres, more or less, according to a plat made by W. A. Christopher, September 29, 1921 and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Old Spartanburg Road, said pin being at the Southeast corner of property now or formerly of G. Cunningham; running thence West with the Cunningham line and E. G.
