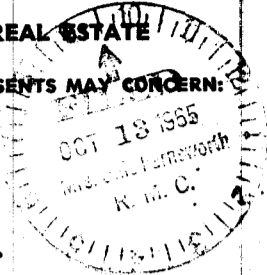

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE
