SEND GREETINGS:

Whereas, I the said Jewell Jordan Kelley  
in and by certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am (are) well and truly indebted to  
in the full and just sum of George S. McCravey Dollars,  
(\$1027.00) payable One thousand twenty seven and no/100  
Fifty dollars on June 1, 1966 and Fifty dollars on the first day  
of each and every month thereafter until the entire amount is  
fully paid

, with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per cent, per annum, to be computed and  
paid annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if  
any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become  
immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further provid-  
ing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note  
and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and  
by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, ALL MEN, That the said Jewell Jordan Kelley  
aforsaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said George S. McCravey  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further  
sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Jewell Jordan Kelley  
, in hand and truly paid by the said George S. McCravey  
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and  
released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
George S. McCravey and his heirs and assigns, forever:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land in the State of South Carolina  
Greenville County, in Greenville Township, on the West side of Flora Avenue and known and  
designated as Lot. Number 58 of Camilla Park subdivision according to said Plat No. 2 of the  
same, made by W.J. Riddle, Dec. 1943, recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Con-  
veyance for Greenville County in Plat Book M page 85, and according to the said plat,  
being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southwestern intersection of Flora Ave. and Harvard  
Avenue and running thence along the west side of Flora Avenue S 20-51 W 81 ft to an iron  
pin at corner with lot No. 57; thence along line of lot # 57 N 60-51 W 208.8 ft to iron
