bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
The Peoples National Bank, its successors or assigns:

ALL those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land, with all improvements thereon,  
or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South  
Carolina, County of Greenville, on the western side of White Horse Road in Paris  
Mountain Township, Greenville County, being shown as Parcels B and C and a  
portion of Parcel A on plat of the property of J. E. Williams made by Pickell &  
Pickell, February 27, 1954, and recorded in Plat Book HH at Page 15, containing  
in the aggregate 16.22 acres and when together described has the following metes  
and bounds, to-wit:
