- (1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. - (5) That it hereby assigns all rents, issues and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and agrees that, should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, any judge having jurisdiction may, at Chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver of the mortgaged premises, with full authority to take possession of the mortgaged premises and collect the rents, issues and profits, including a reasonable rental to be fixed by the Court in the event said premises are occupied by the mortgaged and after deducting all charges and expenses attending such preceding and the execution of its trust as receiver, shall apply the rents, issues and profits toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
- (6) That if there ista default in any of the terms, conditions, or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgagee, all sums then owing by the Moragagor to the Mortgagee shall become immediately due and payable, and this mortgage may be foreclosed.
