ALL that certain piece, parcel er lot of land situate, lying and being on the southeastern side of Linceln Read in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Let No. 23 as shown on a plat prepared by Terry T. Dill, CE Dated October 3, 1959, and revised September 27, 1960, entitled "Section Twe, Plat of Property of Lily Ma. Loftis", recorded in the R. M. G. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book VV at page 29, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Lincolm Road at the joint front corner of lots Nos. 23 and 24, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 24 S. 25-30 E. 167 feet to an iron pin on the subdivision property line; thence with the subdivision property line N. 64-30 E. 90 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lets Nos. 22 and 23; thence with the line of Lot No. 22 N. 25-30 W. 167 feet to an iron pin om the Southeastern line side of Lincolm Road; thence with the Southeastern side of Lincolm Road S. 64-30 W. 90 feet to the point of beginning.
