NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I/Mix the said Johnny I.Brown for and in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for better securing the payment thereof to the said Modern Homes Construction Company according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS to me/mx in hand well and truly paid by the said Modern Homes Construction Company at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto Modern Homes Construction Company, its successors and assigns, certain real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Southern side of Lindsay Lake Road and the Western side of Duncan Road and being a portion of the property of J.T. Childs and Mahaley Childs and having, according to a more recent plat by Carolina Engineering & Surveying Company recorded in the R.M.C.
