"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, which is known and designated as part of tract #22 of the property of E. A. Smythe, et al as per plat thereof in the name of Buford T. Tate recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in plat book R at page 26 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
