WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto The Peoples National Bank of Greenville

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Being shown as a portion of Lot 61 on plat recorded in Plat Book F at page 77 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake at the southwestern corner of the intersection of White Horse Road and Lewis Street and running thence with Lewis Street, S. 79-45 W. 233 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10-15 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 79-45 E. 152.6 feet to an iron pin on White Horse Road; thence with the northwestern side of White Horse Road, N. 11 E. 214.45 feet to the beginning corner.
