WHEREAS, the note evidences a loan to Borrower in the principal amount specified therein, made with the purpose and intention that the Government, at any time, may assign the note and insure the payment thereof pursuant to the Consolidated Farmers Heme Administration Act of 1961, or Title V of the Housing Act of 1949; and

WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, it may be assigned from time to time and each helder of the insured note, in turn, will be the insured lender; and

WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government will execute and deliver to the insured lender along with the note an insurance endorsement insuring the payment of all amounts payable to the insured lender in connection with the loan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of said loan and (a) at all times when the note is held by the Government, in the event the Government should assign this instrument without insurance of the payment of the note, to secure prompt payment of the note and any renewals and extensions thereof and any agreements contained therein, including any provision for the payment of an insurance or other charge, (b) at all times when the note is held by an insured lender, to secure performance of Borrower's agreement hereit to indemnify and save harmless the Government against loss under its insurance endorsement by reason of any default by Borrower, and (c) in any event and at all times to secure the prompt payment of all advances and expenditures made by the Government, with interest, as hereinafter described, and the performance of every covenant and agreement of Borrower contained herein or in any supplementary agreement; Borrower does hereby grant, bargain, sell, release, and assign unto the Government, with general warranty, the following property situated in the State of South Carolina, County(ies) of Greenville
