MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, J. P. Medlock, of Greenville County,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

Eleven Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100-----(\$ 11,500.00) Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 136 of a subdivision known as Colonial Hills, Section No. 3, as shown on a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineers & Architects dated May 7, 1965, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BBB, at Page 91, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
