

(1) A certain piece or tract of land, containing two (2) acres, more or less, situate in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, for the use of the Mission Baptist Church: BEGINNING at a stone; thence, North 17 degrees East three and nineteen one-hundredths (3.19) feet to a stone; thence, North 4 degrees West three (3) feet to a stone; thence, North 72 degrees West to stone at road; thence, South 3 degrees West thirteen (13) feet to stone; thence, South 73 degrees East four and thirty one-hundredths (4.30) feet to beginning corner, except that portion of land which is used as a burying ground, which said portion is to be and remain a burying ground. The above described land is a part of the Henrietta Shockley place and known as Rehobeth Church lot. This being all that tract of land conveyed to J. T. Roe and others as Trustees for the Rehobeth Mission Baptist Church by deed of A. S. Rowell and others, dated October 16, 1909, duly of record in the office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 5 at page 622. (2) All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing seventy-one one-hundredths (.71) of one acre, more or less, adjoining lands of H. H. Garrison, Rehobeth Baptist Church and possibly others, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit: BEGINNING at a point in Pelzer Road and running, thence, along center of Pelzer Road, South 28 degrees West one-hundred seventy-nine and five-tenths (179.5) feet to a point in said road; thence, North 52 degrees West two-hundred fifty-eight (258) feet to a stake, new corner; thence, North 13 degrees East forty-nine (49) feet to center of public road leading from Pelzer Road to Highway Number Twenty-nine (29); thence, along said road, South 81 degrees East two-hundred eighty-three (283) feet to beginning corner. This lot of land is the same lot conveyed unto H. W. Neeley and others as Trustees for Rehobeth Baptist Church, dated June 25, 1947, duly of record in the office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 353 at page 368.

(3) All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Grove Township, State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, containing one-half (1/2) acre, more or less, and adjoining lands of the said Rehobeth Baptist Church and on the South side of its lot of land and lying on the East side of the public highway and otherwise adjoining lands of H. H. Garrison and lands of others. The above lot of land being the same lot conveyed unto C. G. Allison and others as Trustees of Rehobeth Baptist Church by deed of H. H. Garrison, dated March 26, 1931, duly of record in the office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 160 at page 18.
