

TRACT NO. 6:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 7 on revised plat of property of W. R. Cordell made by Dalton & Neves, March 1952 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book Z, at Page 44. Said lot being a portion of a re-subdivision of Lot No. 129, Map 4, Camilla Park as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at Page 117.

Said lot fronts on the Easterly side of Curtis Drive 70 feet; has a depth of 187.5 feet on the Southerly side; a depth of 183.2 feet on the Northerly side and 37.1 feet and 35.7 feet across the rear.

TRACT NO. 7:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the former site of the Odd Fellows Orphanage, about four miles southwest of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of a twenty feet private road at a point 355.2 feet from the Northwestern corner of the intersection of said and private road. With the Old Easley Bridge Road, and running thence S. 47 W. 180 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 43 W. 120 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 47 E. 180 feet to an iron pin on the Southwestern side of said private road; thence along the line of said private road, S. 43 E. 120 feet, to the beginning corner.

TRACT NO. 8:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, including buildings and improvements thereon, situate in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being about three (3) miles West of Greenville Court House, being Lot No. 1, as designated on a plat of the property of Nellie B. Bentley, which plat was drawn by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in February, 1949, and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of a road, 445 feet in a Northern direction from the center of the Easley Bridge Road; thence N. 48-30 E. 335.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 28-30 W. 101.2 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence S. 48-30 E. 342 feet to the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence along the center of a road, 100 feet to the beginning corner.
